THE COLORFUL SMOKY MOUNTAINS

This “*peak-season*” tour has you enjoying the “*colors of Fall*” in the Smoky Mountains and, again, staying in a centrally-located hotel, making every visit close-by!

When we arrive in the Pigeon Forge-Gatlinburg region of Tennessee and this most-inclusive tour package, we’ll be enjoying an evening of entertainment at Dolly Parton’s Stampede Dinner & Show in the Heart of the Smokies. We will be seeing the spectacular main event and enjoying what they term a “*mouth-watering four-course feast*”.

During this four-day tour we will be driving through a scenic byway in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park with our Guide and then having time on our own to enjoy the quaint little town of Gatlinburg. For those interested, we will be visiting a local shop that carries on the tradition of being one of Tennessee’s first legal moonshiners (although this is not to say that it was not being brewed in the area long before that, but we are only guessing). We will have some time to shop or browse in this popular downtown area. But this is just the first day or so in the Smokies. We have also included:

- The Harvest & Gospel Festival, with music and displays, including pumpkins, bring the enjoyable feeling of fall to your heart. It’s an annual event at Dollywood.
- A tradition is deeply rooted in the Great Smoky Mountains, with live music being the heart and soul of fall at Dollywood. They encourage you to be “serenaded by the sounds of a Smoky Mountain fall with Southern gospel, bluegrass, Americana and country tunes”.
- The Comedy Barn Theater with both Country and Gospel Music plus everything from magicians, jugglers, comedians and, possibly, a couple of barnyard animals.
- The Hatfield & McCoy Dinner Feud” combines a long-running family feud and a mountain of delicious food for a journey that starts with an all-you-can-eat feast. The show has musical acts with sensational singing, dancing, some comedy and even some mountain clogging”. The “feud” incorporates “battles” of musical talents and diving stunts.
