TRAINS OF NEW ENGLAND

Suggested tour length is 8 days

Spring, Summer or Fall, the scenery in New England is spectacular. This tour features three train rides. The first ride is from the Boston area to Maine. Imagine passing the sandy beaches and rocky coastline as we travel. Your group will enjoy a narrated tour of the coastal villages of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport and stop at a Maine lighthouse. Our second ride travels through some of the most dramatic natural scenery in the East as you travel through spectacular Crawford Notch over what was once the Maine Central Railroad's famed Mountain Division line. Enjoy some of the most dramatic natural scenery in the East as you pass sheer bluffs, steep ravines, cascading brooks and panoramic mountain vistas. As you travel through this terrain, you will appreciate the remarkable engineering achievement constructing this railroad over 140 years ago. Train number three is aboard the world's first mountain climbing cog railway to the summit of Mount Washington (bring your camera for this view).

This tour has so much that it is impossible to list it all in this write-up, so you'll have to contact us for a complete itinerary. In addition to the trains, you tour Rocks Estate, discover the sweet process of creating maple syrup (with a special recipe that dates back to the Native Americans), travel the scenic Kancamagus Highway through the White Mountains of New Hampshire, tour the Mount Washington Resort Hotel (it took 250 craftsmen to build it), Quechee Gorge, maple sugar and cheese farm, visit Woodstock, Norman Rockwell Museum and so much more.

MURDER MYSTERY DINNER TRAIN

Suggested tour length is 2 days

Old Road Dinner Train - Begin the ride with a "five-star rated dinner" prepared by the famous Hathaway House in Blissfield, Michigan. Then you will be seeing their popular Murder Mystery Show.

- Mad River & NKP Railroad Museum - Housing many interesting items including three former Troop Sleepers which were used by the Army during World War II. Your group will also see all types of memorabilia including uniforms, timetables, lanterns, light fixtures and much more.
- The Henry Ford (or Greenfield Village) - Named after its founder and industrialist Henry Ford, it has become a "National Treasure".

CINCINNATI & ITS TRAIN & CRUISE

Entertainment Junction - The world's largest indoor train display with an area of over half a football field. It includes over 2 miles of track, 90 G-scale locomotives and 1000 cars. The railroad museum shows how trains shaped the growth of the United States.

- Train ride on the Lebanon, Mason, Mornoe Railroad - these are historic rail cars with large picture windows that open to let in the summer breeze or for a Saturday night dinner train.
- Dinner cruise aboard the BB Riverboat and lunch at the historic Golden Lamb.
