## CRUISING ONE-DAY TOURS

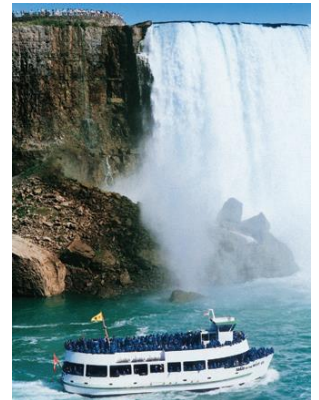

### PRESQUE ISLE BOAT CRUISE
