PITTSBURGH'S STRIP DISTRICT MARKET FOOD TOUR

The Strip District Market tour features a behind-the-counter look at a variety of eateries in Pittsburgh's historic market district. This tour links local history with the eating establishments peppering Penn Avenue with taste samples from around the world including Italian pastries, Mediterranean and Polish specialties, European meats and cinnamon bread. We do this after their "lunch rush" but you get enough samples that it feels like a meal. Choose two of the following to complete your tour:

- National Aviary - get nose to beak with a flamingo. Talk to a parrot and stroll through a 200,000-cubic foot indoor rainforest! Home to more than 800 exotic and endangered birds representing 200 species in natural habitats, the National Aviary is the perfect destination
- Just Ducky Tour - this is a great way to tour Pittsburgh in a fun style! This fully-narrated one-hour land and water adventure takes you through town and then splashes into the river in an authentic WWII amphibious vehicle. Along the way, you'll see the sights and sounds of Pittsburgh, and its important role in history
- Cruise aboard the Gateway Clipper Fleet - there is no better way to see America's "Most Livable City" than from the decks of a riverboat. Enjoy the Captain's expert narration on all things Pittsburgh past and present
- Incline Ride - one of the few remaining inclines in the U.S., a ride on the Duquesne Incline offers a glimpse of Pittsburgh as it was in 1877 (when the incline was built) coupled with a spectacular view of the modern city it has become.
- Carnegie Science Center - the number one exploration destination in the Pittsburgh area features the largest science of sport exhibit in the country, a real WWII submarine, model railroad display, three live demonstration theaters and a building full of 400 handsome exhibits. There is also a four-story Omnimax Theater and an interactive planetarium

SEA LIFE AQUARIUM AND LEGOLAND

Step into the amazing underwater world and come nose to nose with sharks, seahorses, rays and over 5,000 sea creatures. With an amazing underwater 180-degree ocean tunnel and 20 fully themed displays, Sea Life Aquarium is the perfect stop for groups. We even include the behind the-scenes tour. To get any closer, you would have to get wet. Lunch is included at the Rainforest Cafe. Many of our group travelers remember playing with Lego's as a child but Legolands have opened in several major cities. You will be amazed what can be made with legos. This tour includes a visit to Legoland Discovery Center Michigan where you will see dozens of Metro Detroit's iconic landmarks made from Lego bricks . . . and yes, we'll give you a little time to be a kid again plus have a scavenger hunt.
