

**FRIDAY** – A full day to be Dutch – Breakfast is at the hotel before we depart for Windmill Island with its 100,000 tulips . . . it's a beauty to behold. Always impressive, DeZwaan, America's oldest Dutch windmill, stands tall over the gardens. DeZwaan is Dutch for "The Swan" or "Graceful Bird". It was first erected in Krommenie, Holland (near Amsterdam) in 1761 and brought here in April, 1965 and re-assembled. Other stops will include Dutch Village, Veldheer Tulip Gardens, DeKlomp Wooden Shoe & Delft Factory as well as the Queen's Inn for your luncheon. A dinner is included before we take our seats for the just-announced headliner show at this year's Tulip Time, Vince Gill, an American country singer and songwriter who plays a number of instruments. He's sold over 26 million albums as well as winning 20 Grammy Awards, more than any other male country music artist. He's the husband of music artist Amy Grant. It should be most enjoyable. **(B, D, Show # 3)**



**SATURDAY** – After breakfast we depart with our Holland Tulip Guide who will take us, aboard the motorcoach, through the brightly-decorated eight-mile Tulip Lane, pointing out the brightest of arrangements and gardens. You will be learning the history of both the Netherlands and the city of Holland, Michigan, which was founded by Dutch immigrants in the late 1840's. We will be arriving back in town in time to purchase lunch before being seated in our reserved seats for the parade; this year we have purchased upgraded chairs for your seating comfort. First, of course, there will be the traditional street cleaning by townfolk wearing traditional costumes and wooden shoes.

Once the streets are cleaned, the Musiekparade begins. There will be marching bands, floats, giant helium balloons, horses, Dutch dancers and many other participants who have come to this town to join in the festivities. **(B)**
