PITTSBURGH'S HISTORIC CHURCHES



Tour Inclusions – Journey with us today a couple of hours southeast to Pittsburgh, the location of many historic churches. Past church tours have included Pittsburgh's Calvary United Methodist Church in the Allegheny West neighborhood. Built from 1892 to 1895, this Gothic Revival style church has been placed on the list of Pittsburgh History and Landmarks Foundation's Historic Landmarks. The church was beautifully built with treasured Tiffany windows, the largest and most expensive commissioned by Louis Comfort Tiffany at the time. His studios also created the interior design of the church. The Gothic architecture and gargoyles were inspired by Europe's great cathedrals.

While specific churches visited are always subject to scheduling with other events or reasons, past tours have also included the Emmanuel Episcopal Church. It is best known for its squat, rounded shape and brick construction, rather than stone used in most church construction. We discovered that one of the best features of the structure was actually a mistake. After construction was completed the upper wall began to slope outward and has remained that way over the years. During its 150 years, the Rodef Shalom Jewish congregation has grown to be the largest in the city. Donations to each location visited, as in past tours, are included in this tour package.




In keeping with the "church theme" of the tour, our luncheon will be "totally unique" in that we will be dining at the Church Brew Works.
