SINCE 1885, AMERICA'S OLDEST STATE PARK**

This tour travels to Niagara Falls, New York . . . better known as “Niagara USA”. Did you know that Niagara Falls State Park is America’s oldest state park, established in 1885? Best of all, no passport is required since we will not be crossing over the U.S.–Canadian border, staying within New York State the entire time.

We will be dining at a popular restaurant, visiting the New York Power Authority’s Project Power Vista and enjoying a trip on the Maid of the Mist as we “Explore the Roar” of Niagara Falls which was formed in 11,000 B.C. when the last glaciers receded.

The scenic boat trip of the Falls is a spectacular half-hour ride, creating a memory of a lifetime. 100,000 cubic feet of water flows over the Falls every second with the rest of the water being diverted to generators to make Niagara Falls the largest producer of electric power in the world. You’ll be learning more about this ancient site, known as the Niagara Escarpment, as we “Explore the Roar!”
