**WED-FRI JULY 19 – 21, 2017**


Departures, as applicable, from Westlake, Elyria, North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Willoughby, Ashtabula.

We are embarking on another new three-day tour and, while there are “mystery destinations”, we do want to let you know that your tour staff has set up a number of interesting, and new, stops in Western New York. While some folks view Western New York as one community, it is really made up of 17 counties. Successive cultures have called this area “home”, and each has contributed to its history and current towns, some of which you will be seeing during this trip. The Hopewell Indians were some of the first known inhabitants of the area, with Indians creating the early burial sites known as Clovis Mounds as far back as 10,000 B.C. Early Indians were known for their fine copperwork, stone carvings and crops, including tobacco and large fields of corn.

Eventually, in 1687, the Marquis de Nonville, built a fort in the name of the French king but then personally took off to Quebec, leaving his troops with poor food and the inability to leave the fort due to Indians in the area. They could not fish or even gather wood for heat. In 1688, the fort was given up to the British.



During this tour, we will be seeing some history and even more of the current-day Western New York, including little towns and villages as well as a larger metropolitan area as well. All admissions are included as are some unique dining experiences. There will be delightful meals (two dinners, two luncheons and two breakfasts), two nights of rooms and admissions to each of the venues we will be visiting during this Mystery Tour.
