


# Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

Whether you are a long-time resident or were born in Cleveland, you will really be surprised at the changes that have occurred to the Greater Cleveland area. Based on last year's favorable comments, we have brought this same tour back this year. Our Guide will be showing you how "things continually change" such as the Higbee's that most of us grew up with, which has been transformed into a casino, and how the 5 & Dimes are now home to more contemporary venues such as the House of Blues. We will be seeing the expansion of the University Circle area as well as growth of the Cleveland Clinic and museum expansions. Of course, the tour will showcase much more including the new stadiums and arena, the brand-new convention center, the docks and both the entertainment & historic warehouse districts.

Today, at lunch time, we will be dining in Tremont, which is one of the few neighborhoods in the country listed on the National Register of Historic Places, at Sokolowski's University Inn. Established in 1923, this landmark inn is one of Cleveland's oldest family-owned restaurants




. . . and has even served a U.S. President, plus countless Great Day! Tour passengers. You will have various choices of entrees, desserts and the other side dishes.

Originally constructed in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century to provide energy to power the city's streetcars, the Power House is also a National Historic Landmark and is known for its stylish arched windows and distressed brick walls. It is now home to our next visit, the new

Greater Cleveland Aquarium which features 35 tanks of thousands of living creatures, from Ohio native brook trout to sand tiger sharks that grow up to several feet long.


