It was a wilderness filled with oak, beech, maple, walnut and dogwood trees but neither a road nor a bridge to grace the land when Ohio became a state in 1803. Around the turn of the 18th century a gentleman from Pittsburgh loved the area and became the first European settler to live here . . . then the Cincinnati, Midland City & Columbus Railroad (later part of the B & O) was built, bringing freight and passengers to the area.

We will be starting off at the “1950’s: Building the American Dream”. You’ll be seeing a full-sized prefabricated home built in the exhibit and any number of items that just may bring back memories of that era. Expect to see items like a 1957 Chevy Bel Air, an Airstream trailer, Roy Roger toys, a bomb shelter hatch, 1950 television news and programs and many more appliances. We will be bringing back a time of poodle skirts, rock & roll and “ideal family roles”.




