Departures, as applicable, from Westlake, Elyria, North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Boston Heights.


NOTE: For those who can travel mid-week, this year we have added an August 22-24 tour with many additional inclusions.

TUESDAY – Gettysburg & Ghosts – Today we will be traveling to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, the location of the fierce battle during the Civil War. We will be stopping at Sideling Hill for our morning break and then arriving at the National Park Service’s Visitor Center for the showing of the “*New Birth of Freedom*” presentation followed by a visit to the Cyclorama.

Our Candlelight Dinner this evening will be at a historic home that is now a



colonial restaurant. Built in 1776, Alexander Dobbin built the home to begin a new life in America for his family. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, we’ve selected this location for our dinner due to its “candlelit elegance, superior food in abundance and the gracious service that brings back the sights, sounds and tastes of two centuries ago”.



The home was important as it was a “secret underground railroad slave hideout”. It retains its unique country charm as several Civil War bullets are still embedded in the walls . . . as well as the thoughts that some guests claim to have occasionally experienced a “ghost vision” while dining here, an experience we will be hearing about more later this evening.

With all that has happened in this historic town, ghosts are still having an impact on this area which saw the death of so many men. As a result, Gettysburg has been called “*the most haunted town in America*”.

WEDNESDAY – History continues – This tour includes a hot buffet breakfast this morning and afterwards we will be departing with our licensed Battlefield guide to tour the area where the Confederate Army of Northern Virginia, with 70,000 men under the command of General Robert E. Lee and 94,000 men under the command of Major General George G. Meade fought for three days during July of 1863.



A “bit of history” continues as we travel home, stopping in the Somerset area of the Laurel Highlands at an Inn where gentlemen customers originally gathered to “have tea” with their friends during Prohibition at what had been called Oakhurst Tea Room. As you may have already figured out, it was not “tea” but actually illegal liquor being served in tea pots . . . hence it was called a “tea room”. History does, indeed, abound in this tour. We will be enjoying Wednesday afternoon dinner here. **(B, D)**
