FRIDAY – Historic Staunton, Virginia – Today we will be traveling southeastward to historic Staunton, Virginia. While the city that was first settled in 1732 is known as the birthplace of Woodrow Wilson, our 28th president, it also served for a number of years as the regional capital for the Northwest Territory. When the legislators fled Richmond and Charlottesville during the American Revolution it became the capital of Virginia for a brief period in 1781. Originally named Beverley's Mill Place, it



SATURDAY – Monticello and Richmond – After breakfast at the hotel we will travel over to Monticello, the primary residence of our third president, Thomas Jefferson. Built from his own design on land that he, at the age of 26, had inherited from his father it is based in a neoclassical design. It includes many of the same design elements that were popular in late-1800's Europe. Arriving during the holiday season, we will see the somewhat different approach the Jeffersons took as they celebrated the holiday.

Following our tour, we will travel into Richmond, the capital of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Here we will be disembarking for our upscale luncheon at the Jefferson Hotel. Opened in 1895, this grand hotel was designed in the beaux arts style.
