Last year our staff was most pleased to see one of the larger turnouts for our special June tour to Branson . . . with 102 folks signing up and even more on the stand-by list, you know, the ones who waited too long and found that our shows have been “sold out”. This year’s tour is virtually the same although, as has been our practice, we’ve added some new shows and even brought back one of the most popular shows of all time. We will be staying at the Radisson hotel, just off the Highway 76 Strip, during the nights in Branson.

And, due to the popularity, we have expanded the “meal count” to 12, reducing the out-of-pocket costs you’ll incur. Along the way, we’ve included some wine or cocktails as we relax in the evening with our “Kickback Supper” at the hotel, having a coffee stop at a shop offering carvings, cutlery and other products of walnut, plus viewing the Gateway Arch from our coach as we travel to our hotel.

We will be staying along the way at the Saint Louis Union Station, once the nation’s largest train terminal. Both this station and our hotel were built during the “days of luxury”, once housing a plush clubhouse, still retaining the perfectly-preserved terrazzo flooring in the original lobby, a grand staircase with cast-iron railings and marble & slate stairs. No detail was missed as the original wood-framed window arches and the leaded glass windows were restored to the beauty that greeted guests so many years ago . . . features you are sure to enjoy as you partake in their cocktail party.



We have added a new show for this year, “Sinatra & Friends”, with all of Ole Blue Eyes greatest hits and, returning this year, the Shoji Tabuchi Show! Other performances include “New Jersey Nights”, “Dublin’s Irish Tenors & the Celtic Ladies”, “Raiding the Country Vault”, the electrifying true story “Million Dollar Quartet” at the Lawrence Welk Resort (chronicling the night song producer Sam Phillips, known as the “Father of Rock’n’Roll” brought together Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis, Elvis Presley and Carl Perkins for one unforgettable performance) and all of this is addition to Sinatra & Friends and Shoji Tabuchi.
