TUESDAY – We are Canada-bound on what you will discover is an expanded tour for 2018! – We will be departing and traveling east along I-90 through Pennsylvania and New York State, and then crossing into Niagara Falls in the Canadian province of Ontario. The Shaw Festival has been inspired by the work of Bernard Shaw and the shows are so popular that, year after year, more and more artists and audiences are drawn to Niagara-on-the-Lake. This year's show will be held, as in our past tour, in the intimate, yet largest of the four buildings . . . the Shaw Festival Theatre. In its formative years, the Shaw Festival actors toured extensively in the United States and Canada but, in 1973, her majesty, Queen Elizabeth II, officially opened this beautiful building.



We have continued our tradition of providing the most popular shows, this year we have secured tickets for reserved seats for "Grand Hotel", a classic musical, originally performed by Greta Garbo, Joan Crawford, John Barrymore and Lionel Barrymore. The folks in this play are a diverse group of guests at a posh European hotel who struggle through scandal and heartache. It has been selected by the American Film Institute as one of the greatest American films of all time; you get to see the live production of this musical. **(B, D, Show #2)**



THURSDAY – Breakfast is again included at the hotel with some free time to enjoy the hotel amenities or some gaming at the casino. For those who would like to join us, we will be taking an excursion over to the Welland Canal Visitors Center (no additional charge.)

Afterwards, our luggage will be placed aboard the coach and we will depart for the Peace Bridge Duty-Free Shoppe in Fort Erie, Ontario.
