GERMAN VILLAGE HAS STORIES TO TELL

Departures, as applicable, from Willoughby, Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Heights, North Olmsted, Medina, Mansfield.

Located just eight blocks from the State Capitol in Downtown Columbus, the German Village historic district traces its roots back to 1814 in the “South End” of the city. At that time, it was originally referred to as “die alte sud ende”. German descendants, at one time, comprised as much as a third of the entire population of the city of Columbus.

As the immigrants arrived they immediately felt at home since German was spoken in the stores, schools and churches. After work, most of the workers relaxed in “bier gartens” and most belonged to gymnastic and singing societies.

During our combination driving-walking tour of this several-block area you will be learning, from our guide, some of the stories to be discovered as we see the brick streets, wrought-iron fences and brick streets and learning how a small group of urban pioneers triggered the 20th-century restoration of this historic district.

Willkommen! In keeping with the theme of this tour, and taking a suggestion or two from last year’s passengers, we have included your meal at the new Hofbrauhaus, “modeled after the legendary 400+ year-old Hofbräuhaus in Munich, Germany! Guests are now able to enjoy many of the traditions from Germany that have made Hofbräuhaus famous, from the traditionally- decorated rooms in the building to the (optionally available) beer that is brewed on-site”. Upon our arrival, you will be selecting from delicious entrees, as listed below, plus dessert:

- **Schnitzel: Classic breaded pork cutlet, German potato salad.**
- **Wurstteller: Grilled bierwurst, bratwurst and frankfurter, sauerkraut.**
- **Rahm Spätzle: Spatzle with roasted chicken breast, caramelized onions, mushrooms.**
- **Dunkle Bourbon Salmon: Pan-seared Atlantic salmon fillet, with bourbon glaze.**
