WASHINGTON'S MUSEUM OF THE BIBLE MON-TUE AUG 20-21, 2018

Departures, as applicable, from Medina, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Boston Heights.

During November of 2017, the Museum of the Bible opened in our nation's capital to document the narrative, history and impact of the Bible. Among its exhibits are biblical texts and artifacts, with the museum emphasizing that it is nonsectarian and non-political. It contains Bibles which are color-coded in more than 2,000 languages into which it has been partially translated and also a similar amount for which translation has yet to begin.

The museum is housed in a 430,000 square-foot building on eight floors with a view of the U.S. Capitol. "The front entrance contains a gateway with two 40-foot brass replicas of the Book of Genesis as it appeared in the Gutenberg Bible, the version that first brought the holy book to the masses in the 1400s." It has been stated that "the goal was to reacquaint the world with the book that helped make it, and let the visitor come to their own conclusions." The museum displays approximately 1,600 items in its permanent exhibits. You can see the religious diversity in two long term exhibits: *The People of the Land History and Archaeology of Ancient Israel* and *Treasures from the Vatican Museums and the Vatican Library*.

We will also see several of the monuments and memorials in Washington before we go to a delicious dinner in the city. Following our tour of the museum we will depart for home after a hearty buffet luncheon. Three meals are included during this two-day tour.
