This **Customer Appreciation Tour** includes so much and so many cities in these two states:

- **Michigan** -- Charlevoix, also known as “Charlevoix the Beautiful” with Mushroom Houses and even a castle.
- **Michigan** -- Escanaba, a port city in Delta County, and on the Escanaba River in the “banana belt” of the state's Upper Peninsula.
- **Michigan** -- Grand Rapids, the second-largest city in the state and located on the Grand River; it’s the hometown of former President Gerald Ford.
- **Michigan** – Iron Mountain, named for the valuable iron ore found in the area.
- **Wisconsin** -- Fond du Lac, a city that, in French, means “Bottom of the Lake” due to its location on Lake Winnebago.
- **Wisconsin** – Green Bay, the 3rd-largest city in the state and is best known for the Green Bay Packers and its railroad museum; although this city boasts meatpacking plants, paper mills, and a port that connects with Lake Michigan. Our hotel is connected to the popular Oneida Casino.
- **Wisconsin** – Horicon, home of the largest fresh-water cattail marsh in the U.S.
- **Wisconsin** – Kenosha, located on the shores of Lake Michigan
- **Wisconsin** – Lake Geneva, dotted with Gilded Age mansions, many built by wealthy Chicagoans.

This tour has a lot of other surprises that your on-board tour staff member will be showing you during this Appreciation Tour. Plan on boat cruises, one of Wisconsin’s famous supper clubs, a musical cabaret dinner theater, a castle with an extensive outdoor railroad display, a marsh tour by swamp boat, a tour of an iron mine and a lot of sights along the way. We’ll be trying some food distinctively from the areas we travel through, including a ‘Kringle”, a delicious Danish pastry, and a “Pasty”, a specialty baked pastry that is a tradition and part of the heritage of the Wisconsin and Michigan mining and lumber regions as well as in Britain.

The tour also includes the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum, a live performance of the musical-comedy, “Nonsense Amen,” the Frederick Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park with tram tour, Castle Farms, the Green Bay Packers Museum, a railroad museum, and great dining at popular restaurants such as the Old World Italian Dining Room. A total of 16 meals are included in this new tour package, along with a cocktail party at the hotel, as in the past, to celebrate our **Annual Customer Appreciation Tour.**
