WEDNESDAY – American history & American pride – We will be traveling eastward with a coffee stop along the way. Our first stop will be at the Made in America Store. This store, which has been highlighted on national television networks, is the first of several planned for



the country. It offers only products that are manufactured in the United States, including the glue that is used for attaching the labels. Our next stop will be a true American historic site, the D & R Depot Restaurant, originally a B & O train station, where you can purchase lunch. Needless to say, this railroad depot is located along the railroad tracks in the little town of Le Roy, New York. Historic books relate that “In the days of the old railroads, travelers were greeted each day by a newspaper printed on the train from a wireless news service”.

We have also planned a “mystery (surprise) visit” this afternoon with admissions included. At the time announced, we will depart for North Hartford (New York, that is) to check into our hotel. Since we have been traveling today, we will be dining right at the hotel this evening.

Train Station where we will be boarding the Delaware & Ulster Railroad, traveling over a rail line that dates back to 1866 when it was advertised as “The Only All-Rail Route to the Catskill Mountains”.

We will be served specially-prepared meals as we travel through one of the most picturesque mountain ranges, experiencing the “Golden Age of Railroading”. At the conclusion of our rail trip we will be traveling to the dock at Gems Along the Mohawk to board the Lil’ Diamond Canal Boat that will be taking us on a narrated excursion through the Erie Canal.



We will be going through Lock 18 that lowers the boat to meet the Mohawk River. The canal, as you will learn, was the first route for settlements west of the Appalachian Mountains. Following our canal boat ride we will be dining at a popular dockside restaurant. **(B, L, D)**

FRIDAY – It’s German for “sunny hill” – After breakfast at the Inn, we will be traveling to Sonnenberg Gardens, a 40-room Queen Anne-style mansion set atop the hill of the estate. Since 1863 it has expanded and, today, includes beautiful gardens and even a winery. At the time announced, we will be departing for the short ride over to our special luncheon and, since we are in New York State’s Wine Country, we will be enjoying some wine with our meal. Afterwards, we will continue our trip homeward. **(B, D)**
