LINCOLN, AUBURN & REINDEER

SUN-THUR OCT 21-25, 2018

Departures, as applicable, from Willoughby, Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Hts, North Olmsted, Elyria, Sandusky.

This five-day package is a variation on our previous six-day tour as we've kept the most interesting points, while reducing the price by over \$150 . . . there's no reason not to join us this year.

This tour takes us to "The Land of Lincoln" in Illinois. Some of our visits are historic and others are unique, including our visit to the historic 1879 jail that's been converted into a bed & breakfast with themed cells. Even the area downstairs, where the worst criminals were kept, has been converted into a winery, and quite appropriately, re-named the "Drunk Tank". After lunch, we will be boarding the coach with Bonnie and Clyde as we head over to the most-photographed covered bridges. After freshening up this evening we will be enjoying a dinner at a steakhouse . . . but this is just the start. As suggested by the tour name, we will be visiting a couple of places suggested by our past passengers, the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum & Library and Lincoln's Tomb in Springfield. "Chesapeake Bay" was a grand home built in 1857 and, during our meal, we will be joined by Abraham Lincoln himself. Then we will be visiting the only home that the Lincolns ever owned; our visit will reveal Lincoln as a husband, father and politician.



We will be traveling to Monticello, Illinois, and their Railway Museum where the conductor will be punching your ticket as we depart on a train ride through the countryside. Oh, did we tell you that there will be clues for a "murder mystery" along the way?

This tour offers so much, including a planetarium, experiencing life above the Arctic Circle in the "Land of the Midnight Sun", a candy kitchen, the Amish countryside with several rural small businesses and even dining in an Amish home. Enjoy the experience as we "step back in time" at a National Historic Landmark, the historically-rich company deco-styled showroom where, in the 1930's, products of the Cord Corporation were proudly displayed. You'll be standing in the only clay-model studio where the Cord 810 was sculpted and seeing the view from the staircase that E.L. Cord climbed to his office that overlooked the factory complex. Of course, we will also be seeing some of the Auburn, Cord and Duesenberg motorcars of the classic era. We will also be taking a "road trip back in time" with exhibits including a 1948 diner, a carriage factory, roadside cabins from the pre-motel era and even a toy display with die-cast models. The highlight of our tour will be our visit to the Flying Reindeer Ranch where we are typically greeted by the "Klondike Kid", "Yukon" and
