HAUNTED SALEM HALLOWEEN HAPPENINGS WED-SAT OCT 24-27, 2018

Departures, as applicable, from Westlake, Elyria, North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Willoughby, Ashtabula.

This tour came up as a suggestion of two passengers on separate tours this past year. As our staff researched the area, and the events that take place near Halloween, they found it fascinating and offer it for your consideration. Salem, Massachusetts, is best remembered for the "Witchcraft Hysteria" that gripped the area near the end of the 17th century. Research also led us to discover that, while it was originally named after a local river, the early arrivals preferred to call it "Salem", derived from a word meaning "peace"; unfortunately, that word did not always describe the area.

The situations began in 1692 when a local doctor diagnosed several young women as "bewitched". When it ended the following year, the hysteria "played itself out" but it did not help those impacted by being accused of witchcraft. You will be learning more about this as we visit the Salem Witch Museum and the other stops in the area. We will be visiting Boston's Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall as well as experiencing a truly-packed Halloween Happening. We will be having a "Ghosts & Gravestones Trolley Tour", a "Salem Coffee Walk", a "Witchcraft & Ghost Experience", the "House of the Seven Gables" (including their evening "Legacy of the Hanging Judge and the Spirit of the Gables"), the "Witch History Museum" and more. In keeping with the spirit of the Halloween, we'll be serving some Hot Apple Cider with a "Sweet Treat with a Spice Tasting" as we journey through Salem's culinary history. One of our meals will be at the Gloucester House on the Seven Seas Wharf. When booking please advise of your choice of a casual "dine in the rough" . . . a Steamed Lobster & Barbecued Chicken or a New York Sirloin Steak & Barbecued Chicken. This tour includes five meals.
