THURSDAY – We will depart with a coffee break enroute and then continue our trip north into Michigan. Our first stop will be at Cornwell's Dinner Theatre in Marshall, Michigan, as we travel towards Holland. We will be enjoying the magic of live Broadway-style entertainment in the 175-seat theater. Today we will be enjoying the performance of *“Midlife Crisis, The Musical”* after enjoying a bountiful luncheon. With a balanced look at the “joys” of growing older, “Midlife” strikes a chord with anyone regardless of age. A series of scenes and sketches poke fun at the frustrations of mammograms, love handles, weekend warriors and proctology exams. The cleverly crafted songs and humor celebrate forgetfulness, reading glasses and menopause, but also touch on the sentimental wisdom that the later years afford us.



This evening we've continued the opportunity highlighted at the show with a relaxing cocktail party and a light supper to complement the large meal we had earlier today. Sit back, relax and enjoy the company of new friends. It was first erected in Krommenie, Holland (near Amsterdam) in 1761

SATURDAY – After breakfast we depart with our Holland Tulip Guide who will take us, aboard the motorcoach, through the brightly-decorated eight-mile Tulip Lane, pointing out the brightest of arrangements and gardens. You will be learning the history of both the Netherlands and the city of Holland, Michigan, which was founded by Dutch immigrants in the late 1840's. We will be arriving back in town in time to purchase lunch before being seated in our reserved seats for the parade; this year we have purchased upgraded chairs for your seating comfort. While seated, this will be the third show, albeit shorter than the other performances; we will be viewing the fascinating street cleaning by townsfolk wearing traditional costumes and wooden shoes. Once the streets are cleaned, the Musiekparade begins. There will be marching bands, floats, giant helium balloons, horses, Dutch dancers and many other participants who have come to this town to join in the festivities. **(B)**
