

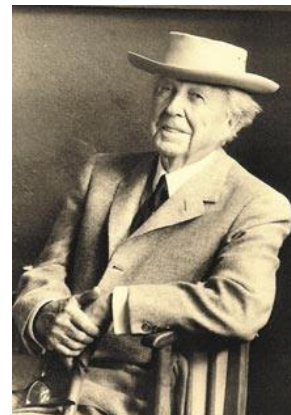
Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S KENTUCK KNOB

TUE MAY 21, 2019

Departures, as applicable, from North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Boston Heights.

In 1953, the Hagan family purchased eighty acres in the Laurel Mountains of Western Pennsylvania. After falling in love with the home of their friends the Kaufmanns, Fallingwater, they contracted with Frank Lloyd Wright and asked if he would design a house for them.



While 86 years old, he was already working on the Guggenheim Museum, a Synagogue and twelve homes. His words were that he could “shake it (Kentuck Knob) out of his sleeve at will” even though he never intended to set foot on the site, except for a short visit during the construction phase. This was one of the last homes completed by Wright.

The tour guides will be taking us through the former residence built in his Usonian architecture, offering insight into the house you are seeing. Come with us as we see a home built with tidewater red cypress, glass and native sandstone, capped with an impressive copper roof.



We anticipate dining at one of the original wayside inns along the National Road, the Stone House. Originally opened in 1822 to wagoners transporting goods through the area as well as weary travelers, this charming restaurant is known for “fine dining and good times in a peaceful mountain setting”. Before this visit, our tour staff has included a visit at the Christian W. Klay

Winery. A couple from New York City began researching grapes and selected almost a hundred types of grapes suitable for a cool weather growing climate. Their original 1,000 vines on their new farm in Chalk Hill, Pennsylvania, have grown to 14,000 vines today. We will be seeing this impressive winery and tasting the fruits of their efforts.
