Franklin Park Conservatory and Botanical Gardens has a rich history that dates back to 1852 when 88 acres was purchased as the site of the first Franklin County Fair. Since then a grand Victorian-style glass greenhouse was constructed with carriage paths, a lake and boathouse, and quickly developed a reputation for horticultural excellence with the display of rare and unusual plants. It will be a great way to start our day.

Franklin Park Conservatory and Botanical Gardens presents multi-faceted, art-influenced and nature-based exhibitions throughout the year; all are designed by the staff. Special, temporary exhibitions by national and international artists are also presented each year.
