WILDS, WINE AND A TIN GOOSE

The African Lion Safari is no “newcomer” to Ohio and has been entertaining guests for years. Spread out over many acres, you’ll be seeing several animals from Alpaca to Zebra, with many others in-between. There are Bactrian Camels which have two humps and are well suited for the colder weather. They have bushy eyebrows, a double row of eyelashes and the ability to close their nostrils to protect from blowing sand.

There are also giraffes, llama, bison, bongos, elk, fallow deer and many other species. The Scottish Highlander cattle sometimes weigh up to 2,200 pounds and can “dine” on 150 pounds of grass each day. We’ll be starting the day to see the animals when they are most lively.

We will also be visiting the Liberty Aviation Museum in Port Clinton. It’s a “working museum” where aircraft, vehicles, and historical artifacts, are continuously undergoing restoration at this airport which still hosts an occasional air event. Generally, guests can view the restoration work as a Ford Tri-Motor (aka “Tin Goose”) is being worked on by the volunteers. No, we will not be flying on this historic aircraft since they were first built over 90 years ago, but it was the world’s first all-metal, multi-engine, commercial airliner. We will be dining on food from the Tin Goose Diner, also located at the airport. It’s a vintage 1950’s diner that is sure to bring back fond memories.

We will also be including the Firelands Winery for a wine & cheese tasting tour and, as a reminder of this one-day tour, your Driver and Tour Director will be purchasing a souvenir glass for you to take home. Talk about “generous” (at least with the boss’s money), this pair will also be “springing” for an ice cream treat before we head for home.
