K9s, VINES & EQUINE

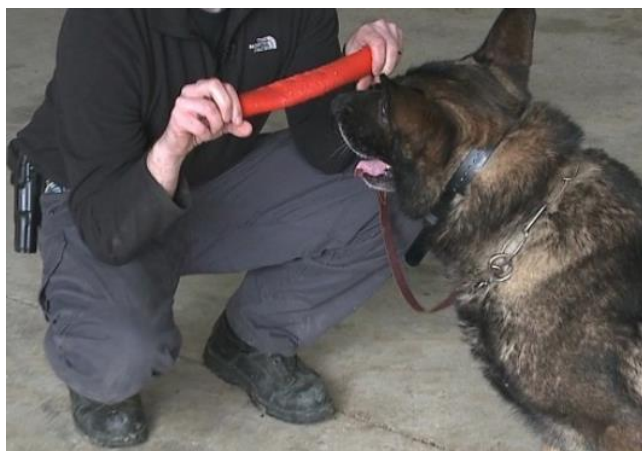
THURS JUNE 27, 2019

This interesting new package travels to an area originally named “Lower Sandusky” in northwest Ohio; while not located near present-day Sandusky, it is located on the west bank of the Sandusky River, about 40 miles from Toledo. While it has nothing to do with this tour, it has a nickname of the “cutlery capital of the world” and was the home of Rutherford B. Hayes who served as President of our country from 1877 to 1881.

One of our first visits of the day will be at a center that trains dogs to serve in the field of law enforcement and the military. We’ll be seeing how these K9s have been trained for over 25 years. These dogs are trained to play catch, learning scents from their unique toys and track down various narcotics. Additionally, if a bad guy takes off running and ignores verbal commands of the officer, these dogs will be employed to “take them down”.



Our luncheon will be at a farm-and-produce restaurant that has a reputation for growing and selling fresh vegetables, herbs and fruit where our meal will be prepared from locally-grown and sourced foods, making for a delicious farm-to-table luncheon.

Then we will be touring Oak Haven which breeds and raises beautiful Belgian horses. Besides time to admire them, you’ll be hearing how they raise, train and show these beauties at fairs and festivals. Our last stop of the day, before departing for home, will be at one of the area’s countryside wineries. We’ll have them serving each person a wine-tasting tray with five wine samples as we listen to the owners telling their personal stories of starting the business and growing it over the years.
