

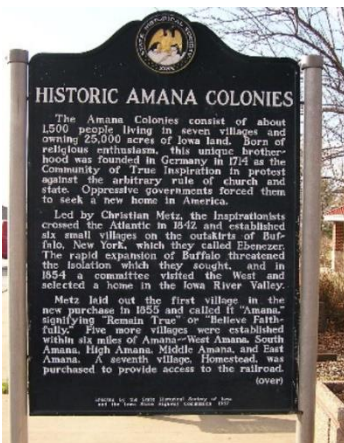
Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

SUN-SAT JULY 7-13, 2019

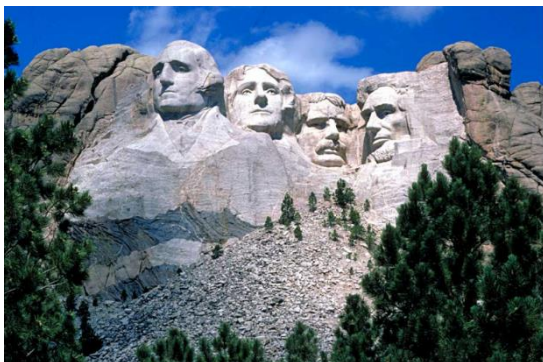
Departures, as applicable, from Willoughby, Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Heights, North Olmsted, Elyria, Sandusky.

SUNDAY– We will depart with a coffee break and lunch stop along the way. Upon our late afternoon arrival in Bettendorf, Iowa, we will check into the beautiful Isle Resort. Dinner is included at the unique Iowa Machine Shed in Davenport. Dedicated to the American farmer, this restaurant with its homemade food has been highlighted on the Travel Channel due to its unique setting and décor as well as its delicious “combination platters” . . . a fitting start to this “tour of a lifetime”. MONDAY – Amana Colonies & Sioux City – A buffet breakfast is included before we depart for the Amana Colonies (Amana, Upper Amana, Lower Amana and four others). After our narrated tour where we will be learning of one of America’s longest-lived communal societies that date back to 1714 in the villages of Germany, we will be enjoying a family-style luncheon at the Ox Yoke Inn; we will be served fried chicken, oven-baked steak and a slice of their freshly-baked specialty pie. TUESDAY – Buffalo Burgers to Wall Drug – This morning, after breakfast, we will head for South Dakota, stopping at the Visitors Center and, midday, at an iconic tour stop restaurant that even offers buffalo burgers on their expansive menu.



No one will soon forget the world’s most unusual Wall Drug Store in Wall, South Dakota. It grew to its current size by advertising “free ice water” along the highway that skirted the town.

In Rapid City, South Dakota, we’ll check into our home for the next two nights. For 2019 we have added yet another meal, this time at the Kol. The cornerstone of the establishment is a massive coal-fired oven, almost 10 feet wide, that glows with a

WEDNESDAY – After breakfast, we will depart with our guide who will be taking us on a day-long tour that includes Mount Rushmore and the Crazy Horse Memorial. Be sure to remember your camera today as there will be so many great sights along the way. Tonight, there is a Chuck Wagon Supper with a cowboy music show starring the “Fort Hays Wranglers”. The supper bell rings out loud to call all cowboys and cowgirls to bring their appetite to the chow line. It’s a popular destination since it was the set for the movie “Dances with Wolves”. THURSDAY – Badlands National Park – After breakfast, we will be enjoying the beauty of the Badlands where thirty-seven million years of wind and water erosion have carved an eerie sight from the prairies of Western South Dakota. We’ve again included the Corn Palace in Mitchell, South Dakota, which has served as a monument to agriculture for over a hundred years. We will be overnighing in Fairmont, Minnesota where dinner awaits us at the hotel this evening. **(B, D)**

FRIDAY – House on the Rock – After our breakfast at the hotel we will be visiting the fascinating House on the Rock in Spring Green, Wisconsin.

The “house” (as it is called) is a most unusual collection of animated displays, instruments that play themselves and even several brightly-lit carousels, some two-stories tall. Dinner is included this evening in Madison, Wisconsin, where we will also be staying. **(B, D)**





SATURDAY – Amish Country Dining Enroute Home – Breakfast is served before we depart for our travels through Illinois and Indiana. We will be stopping in Indiana’s Amish Country (Middlebury-Shipshewana) for our mid-afternoon dinner. There will also be some time to visit the bakery and shops.
