MOUNT RUSHMORE, BADLANDS - EXPANDED SUN-MON JULY 21-29, 2019

Departures, as applicable, from Willoughby, Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Heights, North Olmsted, Elyria, Sandusky.



This 9-day tour has been added to our Mount Rushmore offerings at the suggestion of several past passengers who would have liked additional time at some of the traditional stops as well as several sites that they have not yet experienced but would like to see added to their next tour.

SUNDAY– We will travel to Bettendorf, Iowa, for a late-afternoon check-in at the beautiful Isle Resort, located on the banks of the Mississippi River in the Quad Cities area. Dinner is included this evening.

MONDAY – Amana Colonies & Sioux City – A buffet breakfast is included before we depart for the Amana Colonies (Amana, Upper Amana, Lower Amana and four others). After our narrated tour where we will be learning about one of America's longest-lived communal societies that dates back to 1714 in the villages of Germany. We will be enjoying a family-style luncheon at the Ox Yoke Inn; being served fried chicken, oven-baked steak and a slice of their freshly-baked specialty pie.

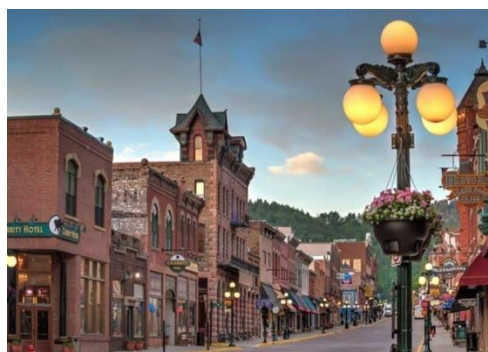

Newly-expanded, this center offers incredible views, a surface tour, exhibit area and, of course, a gift shop. They even have mining artifacts and a 3-D model of the underground.
