This tour is a combination of some of our other Chicago tour destinations, but with a couple of new inclusions as well as several of the “ol’ favorites”. There are two dinner-shows for your enjoyment. Like our other visits to Chicago, this package would not be complete if we did not include a “bit of history”, i.e. a museum that has beautifully-designed cars, including stately Packards, that would have been seen on the streets of

the “Windy City”, along with other beautiful automobiles, military vehicles, and a Presidential Carriage Collection. You will be seeing carriages that were part of the late 1800’s transportation scene in Chicago and across the nation, including the carriages that carried President Abraham Lincoln and other presidents.


There’s just one check-in as we arrive at our suburban hotel which will give us easy access to “freshen-up” before one of our newest additions. Even before checking in, we will be taking you to at a “joint” that harkens back to Chi-town’s “notorious past” with dinner and entertainment at a Chicago “Speak Easy”; reminiscent of the Roaring Twenties with music and memorabilia, it will have you thinking that you’ve stepped back in time almost ninety years. The cast will be singing, dancing and, possibly, trying to avoid the “raid” that occasionally does occur. We’ve selected their upgraded menu that includes entrée choices of prime rib and boneless chicken breast with lemon herb or mushroom sauce.

But we’ll also be seeing the “Chicago of Today” during our tour of the city, viewing the sights along the way. Did you know that the landmark Water Tower, built in 1869, was one of the only structures to survive the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 and today remains a symbol of Old Chicago?

This new tour “combo” includes admissions to the unbelievable Museum of Science & Industry in the heart of the city in Jackson Park, housed in the former Palace of Fine Arts from the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition. Its exhibits include a replica of a coal mine, a German submarine captured during WW II, a huge model railroad display, the command module of Apollo 8, and the “Silver Streak, the Pioneer Zephyr”, first diesel-powered streamlined stainless-steel passenger train.

At the time announced, we will return to our hotel to “freshen up” before traveling the short distance to Schaumburg’s top attraction, the Medieval Times & Dinner Tournament. From the comfort of your seats, you’ll be seeing jousting, horsemanship & falconry plus dining on a 4-course meal served in a castle-like structure. If you’ve not been here before, you are in for a treat at this entertaining venue.



We will also be making a stop along the Magnificent Mile, Chicago’s premier commercial district, to browse a couple of the stores before we say good-bye to the Windy City.

Our mid-afternoon meal will be a family-style dinner feast with some time to visit the gift shop or bakery.
