GO WEST AS WE CELEBRATE THE PAST THUR AUGUST 8, 2019
SAUDER VILLAGE AND THE MV SANDPIPER ON THE MAUMEE RIVER

Departures, as applicable, from Willoughby, Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Heights, North Olmsted, Elyria, Sandusky.



We'll travel westward to the village of Archbold on a tour that was an "instant hit" when we introduced it several years ago and, because of this, we've kept the price the same for 2019. Back in 1934 a local farm boy "with plenty of vision, determination and mechanical ability" founded a woodworking company that has become a world leader in ready-to-assemble furniture. He was also a forward-thinker, aware that the past paved the way to the future, and wanted to document those ancestors who settled in Northwest Ohio in the mid-1830's. In the 1970's he had dozens of structures relocated from various locations to create Sauder Village. Today that area has been expanded to include a 350-seat restaurant, the Doughbox Bakery, a 98-room country inn and a performance center, Founder's Hall. We will be here about four hours to explore the homes and buildings, to visit the craft and retail shops and to dine in their popular restaurant.

Mid-afternoon, we will be traveling about an hour east to board the MV Sandpiper for a two-hour cruise on the Maumee River, seeing various sights such as the new Veterans Glass City Skyway Bridge, the busy port, a shipyard, dry docks and/or stately homes, yacht clubs, marinas and wildlife.
