MARITIME CANADA, SO COMPREHENSIVE SUN-THU AUG 11-22, 2019 FEATURING NOVA SCOTIA, NEW BRUNSWICK, PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

Departures, as applicable, from Westlake, Elyria, North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Willoughby, Ashtabula.

The Maritimes lie in the eastern portion of Canada and consist of three provinces: New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and Prince Edward Island (PEI). This twelve-day tour offers the opportunity to see so much of this beautiful, scenic region of Canada . . . and with stops that would have been missed on shorter tours, given the new high-speed ferry schedule anticipated for the coming year. We will be visiting Acadia National Park and Cadillac Mountain before boarding the ferry to cross over to Yarmouth, Nova Scotia . . . with dinner served aboard this large vessel. Our visits start as we travel along the Evangeline Trail, stopping for lunch in the beautiful seaside town of Annapolis Royal before we continue on to the Grand Pré National Historic Site, seeing the Henry Wadsworth Longfellow statue of the hero in his epic poem “Evangeline”.




Of course, one of the most photographed along the way will be at the enchanting fishing village of Perry’s Cove, with its picturesque ocean setting. Then it’s on to Halifax to visit the Citadel National Historic Site, the star-shaped fortification overlooking the downtown area. A dinner-cruise is included around Halifax Harbor. As with every tour in the past, we’ll be stopping at the Alexander Graham Bell museum before we reach our Baddeck resort. Traveling along the Cabot Trail, one of the most spectacular coastal highway drives in North America, there will be a traditional Gaelic Experience before traveling onto Prince Edward Island and then Charlottetown. We will be learning of the life of Anne of Green Gables and traveling into New Brunswick, and seeing the power of the Saint John River, a waterway that forcefully reverses and forces the water to flow backwards. Scheduling and inclusions subject to ferry schedule being announced.

We will, of course, be seeing other points of interest and attractions as we travel through scenic Maine, the easternmost state in the contiguous United States. Twenty-two meals are included in this expanded package and all passengers are reminded that a passport or passport card is required.
