September is always a pretty time in the area around Traverse City, Michigan, and based on the “raves” we received last year, we have once again arranged this four-day tour for your consideration. Best of all, the three nights are all at the same lodging, Turtle Creek Casino Hotel. Here, each of the rooms are reported to have “casual contemporary elegance” with bathroom countertops of golden amber granite and large 37-inch televisions in each room. Dinner awaits us at Turtle Creek this afternoon. Each passenger gets a slot bonus (\$15 each day).

On Wednesday, we will be touring the area where our planners have arranged for a visit to the Music House Museum which has been selected “as one of the ten reasons to visit Michigan’s Lower Peninsula”. It is a unique collection of instruments that provide guests with a walk through history, the artistry and the engineering of automated music. Afterwards, we



will be meeting our guide for a tour of Sleeping Bear Dunes National Park. The high dunes afford a spectacular view across the lake. There is a fascinating island lighthouse, coastal villages and picturesque farmsteads as we view the miles of sandy beach and bluffs that tower 450 feet above Lake Michigan. We will, at lunchtime, be visiting Cherry Republic in Glen Arbor. Rachael Ray has, after her visit, said that “If Disney did cherries, the results would look like Cherry Republic”. We tend to agree with her. There is even a winery and a Grand Café in this large complex which, of course, offers just about any cherry product you can think of. Dinner will be served this evening in Traverse City.
