MYSTERY TOUR “DD” WITH A TASTE OF HISTORY THUR SEPT 5, 2019

Departures, as applicable, from North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Boston Heights.

This tour will be taking you through a lot of history, from the patriotic efforts in a small town to the science of shipbuilding. We will be seeing how a small town, our first visit on this tour, grew and developed due to the influences of both the coal industry and the railroads. We will be guests at a beautifully-restored city hallmark location, known to millions of other visitors through the years. We will let you in on a secret, i.e. that the first location we will be visiting is located at the midpoint between Pittsburgh and Columbus, a location that led to making the area so important and full of history we can be proud of.

Coal was also “king” in this region and supported many of the trains that along the Pennsylvania Railroad’s Panhandle Division tracks through these towns, several of which you will be seeing. Boxcars, a gas station, coffee and sandwiches were a highlight in the development of these towns during the early and mid parts of the 20th Century, but many felt it was akin to a “dreamy village” . . . as 4,000 folks toiled to make it a success.

You will be hearing fascinating stories at a National Historic Landmark, “acclaimed the most significant remaining example in the nation . . . “ Then we’ll be traveling to yet another attraction but, by now, we are sure to be hungry. Our staff gets hungry, too, so they’ve arranged for a delicious dinner that exemplifies the hospitality of this area of the country.



There’s a visit with a carver of Swiss heritage as we see the history of ships, fashioned from antique ivory, ebony wood and abalone pearl, heavily engraved through an art form known as scrimshaw. Travel back to circa 3000 B.C. on this Mystery Tour. Just in case you didn’t get enough to eat to “hold you over” for the next week or so, we will be making a stop at a packing company to see their fresh offerings before we depart for home.
