WISCONSIN & MICHIGAN

Within the span of a week we will be traveling north through many of Michigan's most popular areas and, as we travel west through the Upper Peninsula, we cross into Wisconsin, capturing the fall foliage coming to the region.



Join us as we visit:

- **Michigan** -- Charlevoix, also known as "Charlevoix the Beautiful" with Mushroom Houses and even a castle.
- **Michigan** -- Escanaba, a port city in Delta County, and on the Escanaba River in the "banana belt" of the state's Upper Peninsula.
- **Michigan** -- Grand Rapids, the second-largest city in the state and located on the Grand River; it's the hometown of former President Gerald Ford.
- **Michigan** – Iron Mountain, named for the valuable iron ore found in the area.
- **Wisconsin** -- Fond du Lac, a city that, in French, means "Bottom of the Lake" due to its location on Lake Winnebago.
- **Wisconsin** – Green Bay, the 3rd-largest city in the state and is best known for the Green Bay Packers and its railroad museum; although this city boasts meatpacking plants, paper mills, and a port that connects with Lake Michigan. Our hotel is connected to the popular Oneida Casino.

- **Wisconsin** – Horicon, home of the largest fresh-water cattail marsh in the U.S.
- **Wisconsin** – Lake Geneva, dotted with Gilded Age mansions, many built by wealthy Chicagoans.

Plan on a boat cruise, one of Wisconsin's famous supper clubs, a musical cabaret dinner theater, a castle with an extensive outdoor railroad display, a marsh tour by swamp boat, a tour of an iron mine and a lot of sights along the way. We'll be trying some food from the region, including a "Danish Kringle" that's part of the tradition and heritage of Wisconsin.

The tour also includes the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum, a live performance, Frederick Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park with tram tour, Castle Farms, the Green Bay Packers Museum, a railroad museum, and great dining at popular restaurants. In our musical, Frank, Dean and Sammy are up in heaven, but God tells them they left some unfinished business back on Earth. It seems Frank made an unfulfilled promise to Vic, the owner of the Rat Pack Lounge. Now he and the boys have one night to make things right. The show includes over 30 songs including their hits "My Way", "What Kind of Fool am I?" and "Everybody Loves Somebody Sometime". Fourteen meals are included.
