

Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary


WASHINGTON, NEW MUSEUM & SHOW

TUE-THUR SEPT 24-26, 2019

Departures, as applicable, from North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Boston Heights.

Please note that we do recommend booking early since this tour sells out quickly after being introduced two years ago. This tour includes five meals and a show.

TUESDAY – We will have a leisurely departure and, after stopping at the hotel to “freshen up”, travel to our dinner. Based on the Whitney Houston and Kevin Costner film, “The Bodyguard . . . The Musical” is filled with her greatest hits including “I Will Always Love You”, “I’m Every Woman” and “I Wanna Dance with Somebody”. WEDNESDAY – Breakfast is included at the hotel before we depart with our guide for more local touring in the Nation’s Capital. We will be seeing many of the monuments, some from the comfort of our coach, the Vietnam Memorial, World War II Memorial and the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial plus we will be visiting the National Museum of African American History & Culture.

We have secured timed-tickets for the new National Museum of African American History & Culture. It’s a Smithsonian Institution museum that was established in 2003 and opened on September 24, 2016. It has almost 37,000 objects in its collection that are related to community, family, the arts, civil rights, religion, slavery and segregation. Alternate visits may include the African American Civil War Memorial. Located at the corner of Vermont Avenue, 10th St, and U Street NW, it commemorates the service of 209,145 African-American soldiers and sailors who fought for the Union in the American Civil War.

Tonight, we will be dining along the boardwalk on Georgetown Harbor, overlooking both the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts and the Potomac River. **(B, D)**

THURSDAY – Breakfast is again included before we depart for Mount Vernon, the home of George Washington. You will be getting a glimpse into 18th-century plantation life through beautiful gardens & grounds and exhibits, all honoring George Washington's life and legacy.



After the death of his older half-brother, Lawrence, in 1752, George Washington took up residence at the house that his father, Augustine Washington, had built in 1735. Over the next five decades, Washington expanded the house to create an impressive 21-room mansion with vibrant wall colors, intricate architectural details, and elegant furnishings. We will be touring two floors of this restored home and the surrounding estate. Following this visit there will be a buffet meal as we travel homeward. **(B, D)**
