WEDNESDAY – By canal boat - We will be traveling eastward with a coffee stop along the way, checking into our hotel and then taking a cruise. This popular tour includes the beauty of the Mohawk Valley as we enjoy a narrated excursion on the historic Erie Canal. We will be going through Lock 18 that lowers the boat to meet the Mohawk River. The lock has continued to work perfectly for over 100 years, utilizing the original equipment. The canal, as you will learn, was the first route for settlements west of the Appalachian Mountains, shortening the trip across New York State from weeks to days. Since the cruise departs from Gems Along the Mohawk, a dining and shopping complex, our reps have set up dinner at a most popular dockside restaurant. **Bon Appetit! (D)**

THURSDAY – By rail and by bus – We'll be traveling aboard the



Delaware & Ulster Railroad, traveling over a rail line that dates back to 1866 when it was advertised as "The Only All-Rail Route to the Catskill Mountains". FRIDAY – “Sonnenberg” is German for “sunny hill” – Listening to past suggestions we will be traveling to Sonnenberg Gardens & Mansion, a 40-room Queen Anne-style mansion completed in 1887. Originally built for a financier and the daughter of the New York State governor, it is best known for its signature floral design and landscaping that was created by hundreds of workers between 1902 and 1919. At the time announced, we will be departing for the short ride over to our special luncheon and, since we are in New York State’s Wine Country, we will be enjoying some wine with our meal. Afterwards, we will continue our trip homeward. Six meals, in total, are included this year and, even though our staff added the Baseball Hall of Fame, we’ve been able to keep the price the same. **(B, D)**
