A “SOUTHERN TEASER” TOUR

Each year our staff assembles a varied Southern Tour for new travel experiences. This tour has again been set up as fall approaches and the colors a little brighter as we visit. Since last year we have “tweaked it” slightly to permit some additional time in New Orleans and to keep the price even more competitive.

- Memphis, named after the ancient capital of Egypt on the Nile River, is home to the Memphis Pyramid; it was built in 1990 as a 20,000-seat arena, but carries on the tradition of the city’s namesake. Of course, Graceland remains one of the top draws for the city. One of the features we added since last year’s book is one of the most unusual, and entertaining, tour of this vibrant city than you will ever find on any other tour.
- New Orleans was originally named La Nouvelle-Orléans when it was founded in 1718 by the French Mississippi Company. This year we will be arriving earlier in the afternoon to permit even more time to enjoy it.
- Tunica is known for its gaming, and we will again be staying at a casino resort. You will, of course, have time for some gaming here as well as at Harrah’s in New Orleans, if you are so inclined.
- Birmingham is a city, founded during the post-Civil War period, in an area with rich mineral deposits that made it an ideal location for iron smelting.
- Bowling Green, history has it that, “in 1775, a ragtag band of explorers called ‘long hunters’ reached the banks of a meandering river, where they carved their names on beech trees to mark their passage through this vast wilderness.” A unique dinner is included at a place we discovered last year.

During these seven days we will be visiting each of these cities as well as being guests at Elvis Presley’s Graceland and dining at a Victorian Tennessee Mansion that dates back to the late 1800’s where entertainment and a great meal awaits us. You’ll be seeing much of New Orleans’ history. We’ve also set aside, for those interested, time for a bit of gaming in Tunica and New Orleans. Fourteen meals are included, with one being along Beale Street at B.B. King’s in downtown Memphis . . . it’s considered the “Home of the Blues and the Birthplace of Rock & Roll”. You’ll be “getting the feeling” of the city while we are here. Since New Orleans is known for so much, we’ll be dining here on the delicious food that brings so many people here each year.
