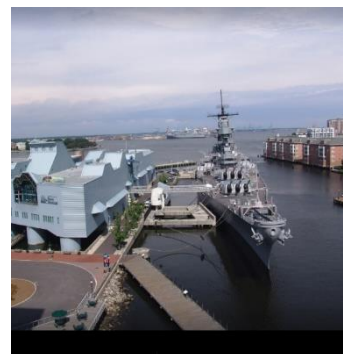
VIRGINIA MILITARY HISTORY

FIVE DAYS TO ENJOY THIS TOUR WITH VIRGINIA BEACH & NORFOLK

Departures, as applicable, from North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Independence, Beachwood, Boston Heights.

The military history in the Commonwealth of Virginia goes back many years. As a matter of fact, it was established in 1607 as part of the English militia system. Militia service in Virginia was compulsory for all free males with the expressed purpose to repel invasions and insurrections and to enforce the laws of the colony. Since that time, it has evolved through the French & Indian War, the Revolutionary War and stands ready, even today, as you will see during this new tour. Our exploration begins at the Virginia War Museum where military history unfolds.



These collections of personal artifacts, weapons, vehicles, uniforms and posters trace the development of the U.S. military from 1775 through the present. Our tour guide will be taking us to Naval Base Station Norfolk, the largest naval installation in the world. We'll be driving past historic homes built for the Jamestown Exposition on Admiral's Row and a number of military vessels.

You'll be learning about the power of the sea at Nauticus and then touring the Battleship Wisconsin, the largest battleship that served in World War II. Then we will be making a stop to pick up one of the famous ice creams on a waffle cone from the shop that invented the waffle cone by taking a waffle and rolling it into a cone, then adding ice cream to it.



We will also be taking a cruise tour aboard the Victory Rover through the bustling Hampton Roads Harbor, with a fascinating and entertaining commentary. Our next stop will be at the Virginia Beach Surf & Rescue Museum, a former life-saving station dating back to 1903, and then the Military Aviation Museum, one of the largest private collections of World War II and Korean War era fighters, bombers, trainers and seaplanes. Eight meals are included in this new tour package for 2019.
