We are bringing back this one-day Mystery Tour that we first offered back about fifteen years ago . . . and, like some of our previous tours, have updated for 2019. There is evidence of ancient settlement in the Village with historic mounds in the region, none of which we will be exploring during this period . . . but we did want to throw you off as to our destination. The earliest peoples inhabiting this area were the Hopewell Native Americans, who were responsible for many of the earthworks, with the first Europeans arriving about 1800.

We will be visiting an area that was first surveyed in 1797 as part of the U.S. Military District. These were lands set aside for those who had served in the Revolutionary War. Land was acquired, according to an Act of Congress in 1796, in units of 4,000 acres. First settled by the Welsh in the early 19th Century and then by settlers traveling west from Massachusetts and Connecticut. We will be taking in the beauty, as our coach travels along, of nearly 2,000 acres of plant collections, gardens and natural areas.

After our luncheon, we will be visiting a glass museum with beautiful glassware and a gift shop if you are so inclined to do a little shopping, or a lot of it, while we are here. Some of the glassware is high quality and hand-wrought, dating back to 1896.

Who knows, your Driver and Tour Director may even be planning on a visit to a popular ice cream company for a brief tour and “spending some of the boss’s money” on an ice cream treat before we travel homeward.
