

Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary


CINCINNATI & ITS DINNER TRAIN & CRUISE SAT-SUN APRIL 4-5, 2020

Departure locations, if applicable, include Beachwood, Independence, North Olmsted, Middleburg Heights, Medina, Mansfield, Columbus, Grove City.

Saturday - A coffee stop will be made at the McDonald's Restaurant in the Mansfield area and, a couple of hours later we will be arriving in Cincinnati at Entertainment Junction, the world's largest indoor train display with an area of over half a football field. It includes over 2 miles of track, 90 G-scale locomotives and 1000 cars. This railroad museum shows how trains shaped the growth of the United States and was one of the highlights of our past tours, and introduced both rail, and non-rail, guests to a fascinating display.



Try to imagine that these locomotives are about 20 to 24 inches long! During our past tours, we have had the opportunity to see the behind-the-scenes operations and the intricate computer control system used, just as on the real-life railroads.



The "tour highlight" this evening will be special as we board the Cincinnati Railway's Dinner-Train.

This 3-hour 1940's-style train excursion in vintage cars includes a 4-course dinner & a cash bar in the New York Central dining car # 447.



Trips typically include a 40's-style singing group performing songs such as "Chattanooga Choo Choo", "Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy" and other great hits of an era from the past.

This year we have upgraded the inclusions in this already-popular tour . . . and an additional meal as well! At the time announced, the coach will depart for Newport Landing where we will board the Sunday Dixieland Jazz Brunch Cruise aboard the BB Riverboat. Enroute home we will be making a stop at the Cincinnati Museum Center at Union Terminal. The Cincinnati Union Terminal was a significant development in the history of the area's

transportation. One of the last great train stations built, the Union Terminal is a Cincinnati icon and one of the most-widely regarded examples of Art Deco style. Since opening in 1933, the Union Terminal has had a long and storied history, from welcoming soldiers home from World War II to becoming the home of three museums, a theater and the Cincinnati History Library & Archives. The terminal was designed to accommodate 17,000 passengers and 216 trains each day. Passenger train service left Union Terminal on October 28, 1971, and resumed July 29, 1991, when Amtrak began operating here. Today we will be visiting the magnificent Rotunda. **(B, Jazz Brunch)**
