Before the show we will be dining at the Steele Mansion. Built in 1867, it was described in newspapers as the “grandest home in the area”! The French Second Empire home featured a ballroom, eight Italian marble fireplaces, windows imported from France, bathrooms with running water and ornate walnut doors, stairs and trim.
