GERMAN VILLAGE HAS STORIES TO TELL

Located just eight blocks from the State Capitol in Downtown Columbus, the German Village Historic District traces its roots back to 1814 in the “*South End*” of the city. At that time, it was originally referred to as “*die alte sud ende*”. German descendants, at one time, comprised as much as a third of the entire population of the city of Columbus.

As the immigrants arrived they immediately felt at home since German was spoken in the stores, schools and churches. After work, most of the workers relaxed in “bier gartens” and most belonged to gymnastic and singing societies.

During our combination driving-walking tour of this several-block area, you will be learning, from our guide, some of the stories to be discovered as we see the brick streets and wrought-iron fences, learning of the urban pioneers triggered the 20th-century restoration of this historic district.
