Here's a tour that just might be an opportunity to include so much, and this combination is available only through the end of March due to the limited exhibition dates.

The Franklin Park Conservatory will be awash in the vibrant colors of the stunning glass artwork by Dale Chihuly . . . the same renowned artist whose Café we include during our tours of the Frederik Meijer Gardens in Grand Rapids, with its dozens of individual blown-glass pieces, spanning the ceiling in a spectrum of colors. Today we will be seeing the largest permanent Chihuly collection in a botanical garden setting, proudly proclaiming the title *"Chihuly: Celebrating Nature"*. For those not familiar with the history, Chihuly began experimenting with glassblowing in 1965, and eventually was awarded a Louis Comfort Tiffany Foundation grant for his work in glass. He later traveled to Venice to learn the detailed intricacies of blowing glass.

Our luncheon will be unique too, as you will have a choice of five specialty entrees (from tasty dishes to large salads) followed by an upgraded dessert from the California-based Cheesecake Factory, no less.
