

Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary


INDIANA, PENNSYLVANIA

We will be traveling into Pennsylvania and the hometown of iconic actor Jimmy Stewart. The tour will be starting at a restaurant, located in a Victorian Home in downtown Indiana. You will be welcomed into their vintage chic atmosphere, known for its rich ambiance, superb food & outstanding personal service.



Take a few minutes to explore all seven dining rooms of the Victorian house, decorated in what they refer to as "Vintage Chic", surrounded by memorabilia of days past and located just up the street from the Jimmy Stewart Museum. Here, you will be dining on your pre-selected entree of: **Flat Iron Steak, Chicken Parmesan or Cedar Plank Salmon**. Please advise the reservationist (or in the "notes box" of online orders) of your entrée choice when booking this tour.

We will have a Guide join us on the motorcoach as we do a driving tour of Jimmy's hometown. After the driving tour, we will be visiting the Jimmy Stewart Museum. It's located on Philadelphia Street (*The Philadelphia Story?* . . . a coincidence, perhaps?). While we are here, we may even have a surprise guest.



The Museum celebrates Indiana, Pennsylvania's most famous native son. Jimmy was still



living there at the time the Museum was being planned and vetoed an idea to make a large spectacle-of-a-museum, as originally considered, and actually picked out most of the items to be placed on display.

Among the more notable Hollywood artifacts you'll be viewing is a propeller blade autographed by the cast and crew of "Flight of the Phoenix," and a six-foot-tall stuffed rabbit representing Stewart's invisible pal in "Harvey" near the Museum's life-sized statue of Jimmy.

With the tasty vintage-themed luncheon we've included, through the narrated tour of Indiana, Pennsylvania, the Museum and, perhaps, a friend or two, this should make for a "Wonderful Life", as Jimmy might say!
