Today we will be traveling to Belmont County in the beautiful Appalachian Foothills. Our destination is a working ranch that is famous for the breeding-quality Texas Longhorn cattle which are raised, sold and transported worldwide to customers in Poland, Canada, Brazil, New Zealand, Puerto Rico and Australia, to name a few of the destinations.



This is the largest ranch of its kind in the United States and is the biggest producer of All-Natural Pasture-Raised Lean Beef in the area. It's a working ranch where you will be seeing up to 1,000 Texas Longhorns, learning modern conservation, ecology, and, possibly feeding one of these beautiful animals. During this interpretive tour you'll have up-close views of BueLingo, Texas Longhorn and African Watusi cattle herds as the ranch buses travel across the pastures as we "go where the cattle roam". FYI, the Watusi are the largest horned cattle in the world.

You will have the option to get some "special cow candy" if you'd like to hand-feed the "cast members". A luncheon will be served during our visit to the ranch today. After lunch we've allowed time to visit the Longhorn Head to Tail Store that offers everything from lean beef, jerky, smoked snack products and summer sausage to leather products and powder horns.
