HOLLAND TULIP TOUR WITH SHOW

As in the past, we know of no other tour offered that has so many inclusions. This tour has an entertaining show and now 6 meals (one more than ever before). The tour itinerary has been updated to reflect several changes in Holland and we have expanded the tour with some brand new experiences and the additional meal . . . at a steak house, no less, this year.



Thursday

- Departures, with rest stop(s) en route as we travel to Michigan.
- Arrive Cornwell's Dinner Theater where you will be enjoying one of Turkeyville's mid-day dinners, followed by the live performance of a Cabaret-type show which has been described as "providing uplifting Broadway Classics and fun Cabaret Favorites".
- Late afternoon we will be checking into our hotel and having a light meal
- As always, we've planned this tour so that you can rest up this evening before our Holland touring tomorrow.

Friday

- Breakfast is included at the hotel.
- We will be starting out in Holland with an "orientation tour" as we travel along the eight-mile Tulip Trail, seeing the beauty of the village that attracts so many people each year.
- Our first visit in town will be at the Nelis' Dutch Village where admissions are included and there will be time to purchase lunch.
- This afternoon in Holland we have included admissions to Windmill Island (with its hundred-thousand tulips), Der Klompen Wooden Shoe Factory, the Delft Shop and the Veldheer Tulip Gardens. Of course we've included the ever-popular DeZwaan ("the swan") the country's oldest Dutch Windmill.
- We have upgraded the dining experience today to dinner at a popular Steak House with various entrees to select from . . . plus a glass of wine or beer to complement your selection.

Saturday

- A leisurely breakfast is again included at the hotel before we board the motorcoach.

luncheon, will be at what just might turn out to be the highlight of the tour, based on the great reviews from our past guests here . . .

- Keeping with the theme of this tour, with all its floral beauty, admissions are included for the Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park', a destination that many of our past travelers have considered the "highlight" of our tours to this area.
- We have further upgraded the inclusion by adding timed tickets for the trams to take us through the 158-acre botanical garden and outdoor sculpture park where you will experience masterpieces of art and nature that will delight your senses at one of the nation's premier horticultural display gardens. The Sculpture Park features significant works of art within a variety of natural settings connected by waterways, meandering paths, lawns, meadows and quiet walkways. As we travel through the campus you can see more than 50 major works by masters such as Auguste Rodin and others.
- And, for the third addition, we've included your luncheon-voucher so that you can select your luncheon today at the "*Taste of the Garden Café*". It's named "*Lena's Garden*" in honor of Lena Meijer. This dining room area, on this upscale visit, is spectacular with its dazzling glass ceiling sculpture by renowned artist Dale Chihuly; the sculpture, comprised of dozens of individually blown-glass pieces, spans the ceiling in a spectrum of colors from cool greens, cobalt blues and purples to brilliant oranges, yellows and reds. With an emphasis on local products, Meijer Gardens' globally-inspired menu changes with the seasons . . . a fitting way to conclude our tour to Michigan's Lower Peninsula.
