

Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

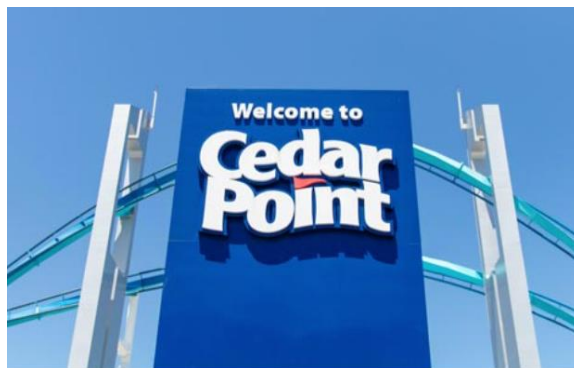
CEDAR POINT BOUND

While many people may not be aware, Cedar Point is a peninsula along Lake Erie, near Sandusky. About the start of the American Civil War (1862), a 38-foot lighthouse was built to protect boats from running aground; it remained in use for almost 47 years. Federal troops were stationed here to both guard Sandusky Bay as well as to monitor the Confederate Prison on Johnson's Island.

Then, about 150 years ago, Cedar Point Amusement Park was created to bring tourists to the area. The first major development went to constructing bathhouses and picnic areas in 1870. Steamboats brought guests from Detroit and Cleveland while railroads did the same. A lot of money has gone into the improvements that greet visitors now-a-days, leading the park to receive awards for "Best Amusement Park" and "Roller Coaster Capital of the World". There are rides, entertainment, games and many restaurants in the park.
