

Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

CHICAGO'S ARCHITECTURE, DINNER SHOW WED-FRI JULY 21-23, 2021

Departures, as applicable, from Willoughby, Beachwood, Independence, Middleburg Heights, North Olmsted, Elyria, Sandusky.

This tour for 2021 is a combination of popular Chicago destinations that have been enjoyed over the years. In addition, we have “splurged” by including, for the first time, one of the top restaurants as well as a dinner-show.

This package includes a “bit of history”, i.e. a museum that displays stately Packard Motor Cars that were seen on the streets of the “Windy City”, along with other beautiful automobiles, military vehicles, and Presidential Carriages that were part of the late 1800s transportation scene, including the carriages that carried President Abraham Lincoln and other presidents.

But we'll also be seeing the “Chicago of Today” during our tour of the city, viewing the sights along the way. Did you know that the landmark Water Tower, built in 1869, was one of the only structures to survive the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 and today remains a symbol of Old Chicago?

This new tour “combo” includes the unbelievable Museum of Science & Industry, housed in the former Palace of Fine Arts from the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in the Hyde Park area. This museum, initially endowed by a president of Sears, Roebuck and Company when it opened in 1933, is the largest center of its type in the Western Hemisphere. Exhibits include a full-size replica of a coal mine, a German submarine (U-505) captured during WW II, a huge 3,500 square-foot model railroad and the command module of Apollo 8. You will also be seeing “Silver Streak, the Pioneer Zephyr”, which was the first diesel-powered streamlined stainless-steel passenger train (see photo on right). Most interesting is the new entranceway which has been constructed similar to the Louvre Pyramid.

While its beautiful on the outside, it is the experience you will be having this evening. We are generally greeted in the dining hall by His Majesty or Milady, who will be with us as we dine in the festive and colorful atmosphere. During dinner there will be entertainers performing staged medieval-style games and jousting with, perhaps, some fencing.
