


Great Day! Scheduled Tour Summary

ANDY WARHOL, BIRDS AT THE NATIONAL AVIARY THUR AUG 5, 2021

This “top shelf” tour includes the phenomenal Andy Warhol Museum and, in keeping with the theme of this tour, our luncheon will be served amidst an elegantly-preserved former Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad Station, with its marble columns, stained-glass ceiling and a dramatic staircase flowing into the dining room.



The Andy Warhol Museum, also known as “*The Warhol*”, tells his life story and explores his legacy through the largest collection of Warhol art and archives in the world. The museum chronicles his life as a filmmaker, a painter and a magazine ad illustrator who became one of the best-known artists of the Pop Art Movements. He converted various products into “*pop paintings*” which included Coca-Cola bottles and vacuum cleaners. Some of the celebrity portraits have sold for up to \$100 million. Join us as we look at the life of this American Icon.

Rounding out the day, we’ve included a tour at The National Aviary whose collection features birds representing most every continent. Many of these species are showcased in free-flight exhibits, allowing the birds to demonstrate natural behaviors. The National Aviary features more than 500 birds of over 150 unique species from around the world.
