In 1788 pioneers of the Ohio Company made Marietta the first permanent settlement in our



country's Northwest Territory. Join us as we rediscover this picturesque river town and, in keeping with the theme, we we'll be dining at a historic Inn which got its name from the Marquis de Lafayette, the first "tourist" to visit here.

Marie-Joseph Paul Yves Roch Gilbert du Motier, better known as "Lafayette", was a French aristocrat and military officer in the Continental Army who fought in the American Revolutionary War. He commanded American troops in a number of battles, including during the Siege of Yorktown, while commuting back and forth to Europe where he served as a Lieutenant General in the French Army during the French Revolution.

We will be dining in a room known for its collection of long rifles, each identified for its place in history. Enjoy dining on items such as Pecan-Crusted Salmon, Chicken Piccata or Honey Glazed Ham.



We'll then travel to the dock on the Ohio River to board the paddlewheel riverboat, cruising one of Marietta's two navigable rivers, and crossing the border into West Virginia. There is nothing like the gentle splash of the paddlewheel on a warm Saturday afternoon to remind you of a bygone era.

As we travel homeward, a brief rest & shopping stop will be made.
