This 2021 tour is most relaxing since all three nights are at the same Nashville hotel, with just one check-in and one check-out. We've included 7 meals and 4 shows. In addition, our staff has included the city's newest attraction, the Madame Tussauds Wax Museum. Here, the world's most famous attraction of its type is "celebrating American music", focusing on the lyrical legends that have shaped the country's musical landscape of America. This multi-sensory experience will make you the star of the show by allowing you to get up close and personal with some of your favorite musical talents. It will take you on a journey through time alongside a colorful cast of iconic figures from the worlds of country, rock, pop, jazz and blues. The next morning, we will be having breakfast before our narrated tour of Nashville Music City USA. One of the stops will include admissions to the Ryman Auditorium, a



"*living museum*"; "*where it all started*". At lunch time you will be in Downtown Nashville where you can select from the many choices of restaurants; there is bound to be one that best suits you, Nashville-Style. Our next stop has us traveling over to the Country Music Hall of Fame & Museum. Music and history lovers always enjoy the exhibits found here, from plaques dedicated to country music's finest, from Patsy Cline to Johnny Cash, and walk among artifacts like Jimmie Rodger's guitar and Elvis Presley's solid gold Cadillac limo.
